

# Thanks Lotterywest!

On Thursday 21st July, local MP, Terry 'Tuck' Waldron presented the Shire of Williams with a cheque for \$193,577 from Lotterywest to go towards refurbishments of the Williams Town and RSL Halls.

Making the presentation to the Shire President, John Cowcher, Terry congratulated the Shire on its ongoing commitment to improving the amenities in the town for residents and visitors alike.

"I am continually amazed at the great work Williams community does, from the new ambulance sub-centre last year, and now the planned refurbishments for the halls, the Shire of Williams is a great ambassador for its community and making a real difference in improving community facilities for all to enjoy" Terry said.

Shire CEO, Ryan Duff, said the Lotterywest funds, together with funding provided by the Federal government and the Country Local Government Fund, make up the over \$350,000 in funding that has been received to fund the planned work.

Improvements include a new roof and an upgrade in the lighting and electrics (already completed), as well as solar panels, painting inside and out, an upgrade for the male and female toilets, reverse cycle air conditioning and meeting room equipment for the RSL hall, making the bar area more secure, new blinds for the main hall and an upgrade for the bio box at the rear of the hall.

It is anticipated that work will commence over the next few months to be completed during 2012.
