A number of items specifically on Landcare are near the reference section of the Williams library. There are too many to mention them all, but here is a taste of what is available:

"Tracks, scats and other traces" by Barbara Triggs, A field guide to Australian Mammals, organized for easy identification of the visible traces left by Australian mammals. This includes tracks, scats, shelters, feeding signs and bones. If you don't know what scats are - come and borrow the book!

"Earth quest": *the family guide to protecting the environment*, published by Channel 9, this book will enable you to not only learn more about the environmental problems which confront us, it also details simple things we can all do to help ease the crisis.

"Trees for the back paddock", by Nan Oates and Brian Clarke, although this is a slightly older volume it contains valuable and methodically presented knowledge on soils, farm productivity, species selection, layout and design, site preparation, regeneration and early maintenance.
